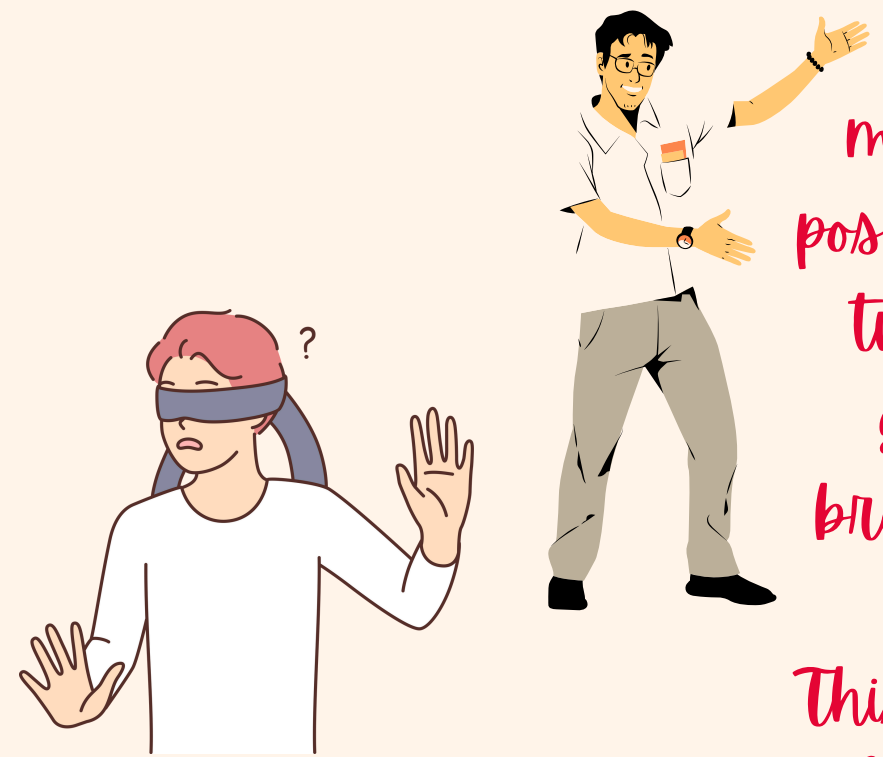




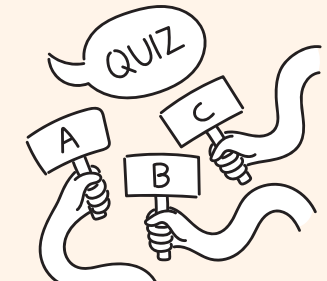
# Special

This blend of skits, competitions, and surprise moments made the Children's Day celebration both entertaining and memorable, with a strong sense of community between teachers and students.



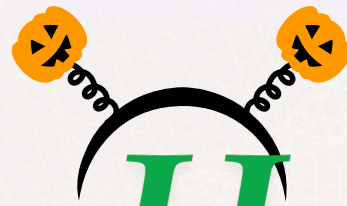


# Cooking without fire

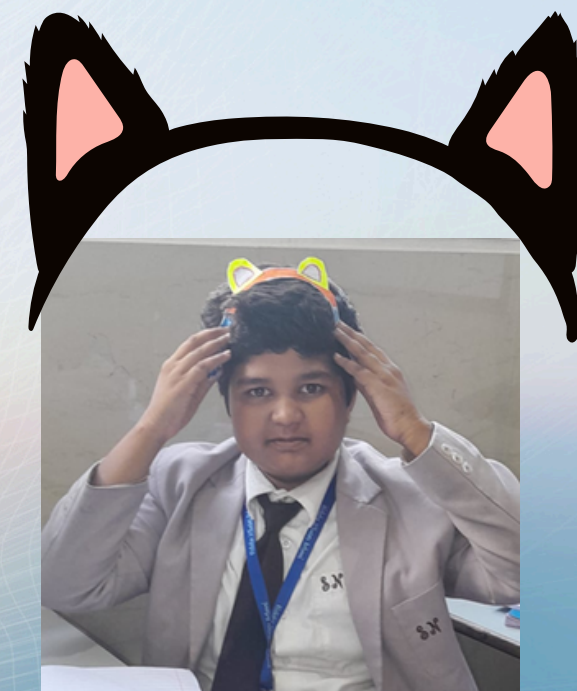




# Headband Making

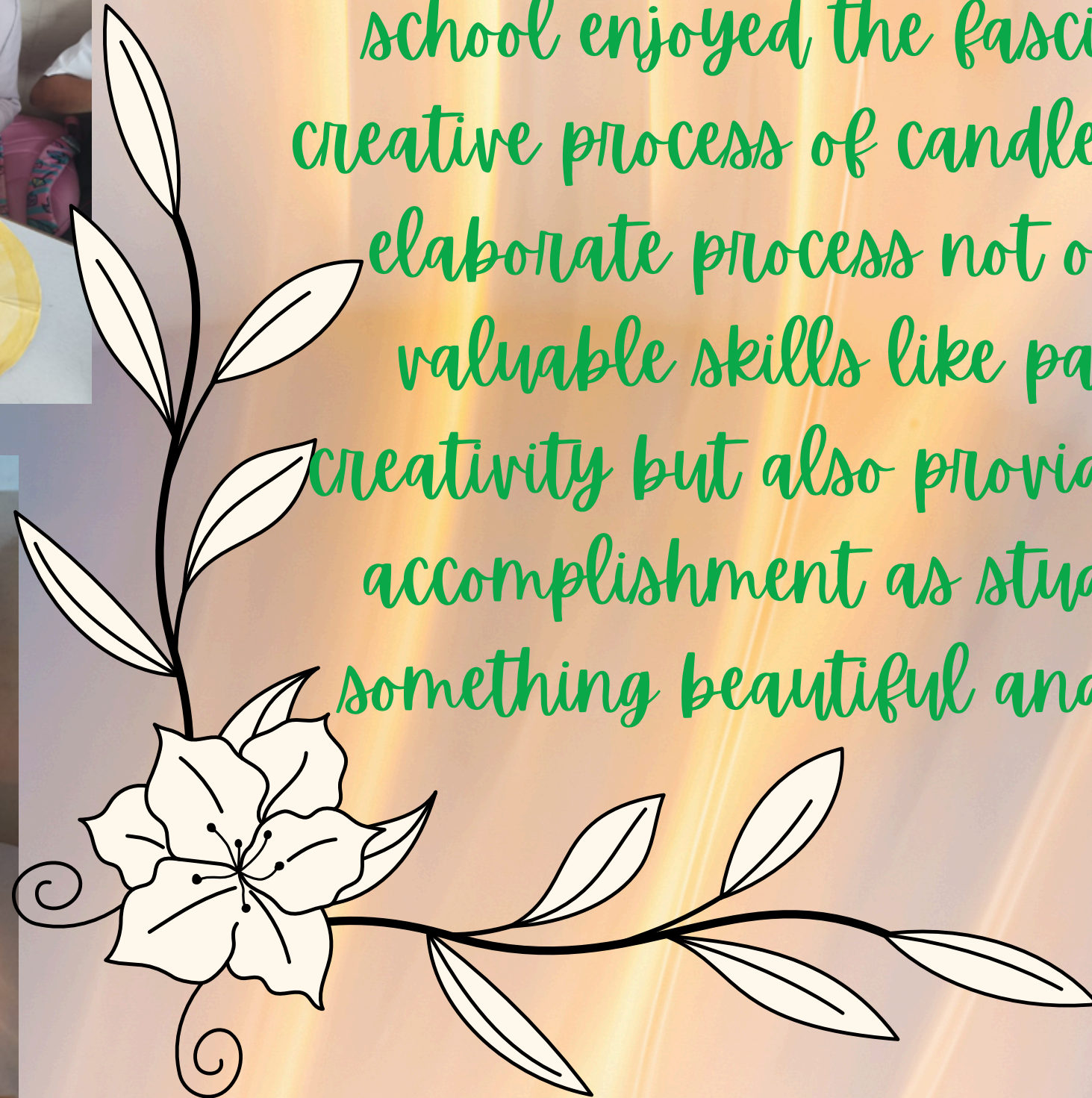




# Candle making
