This playful exercise helps strengthen hand muscles, improve fine motor skills, and enhance hand-eye coordination



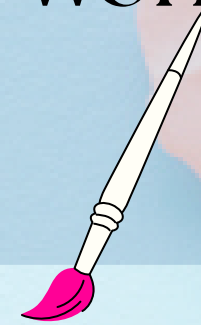
Through this fun hands-on activity, learning becomes enjoyable and meaningful for little learners.

Through learning about fish, children gain an understanding of marine life and the importance of protecting our environment



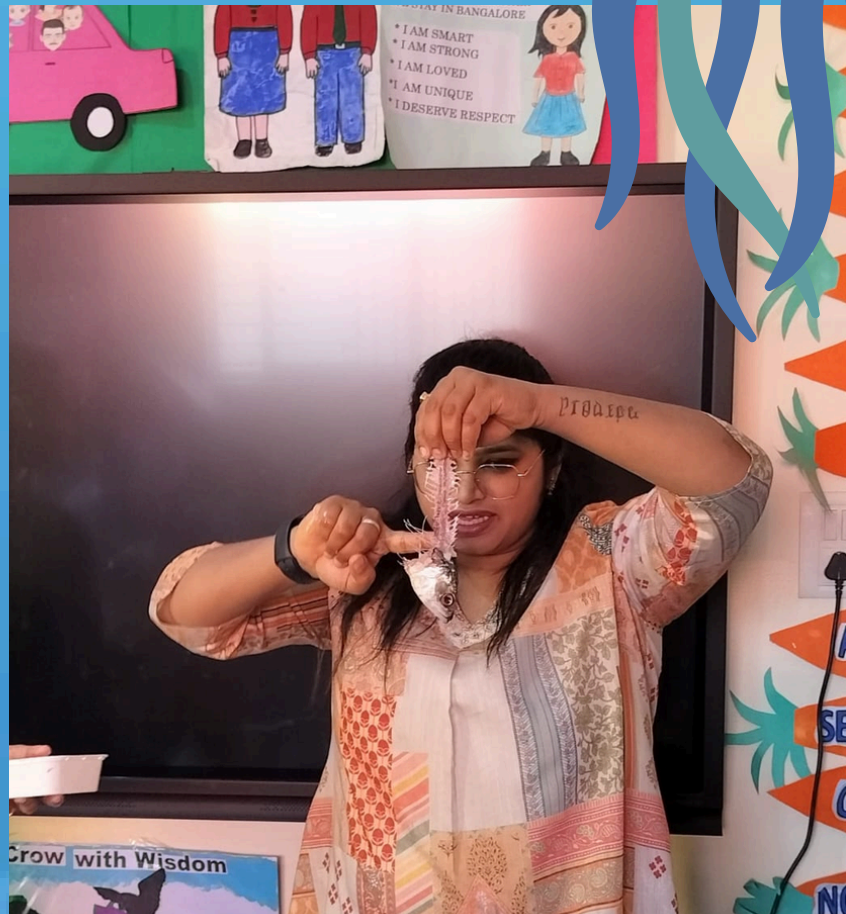
By learning about fish, children discover how marine animals live, grow, and depend on clean oceans. They begin to understand how pollution, overfishing,

# Turning Pages, Building Awareness: Indian Newspaper Day at Shiksha



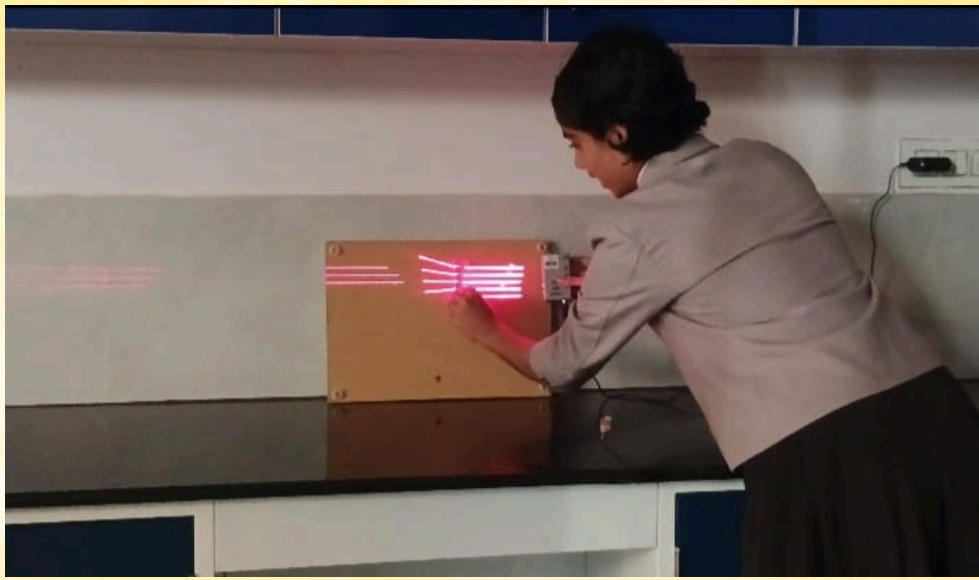
On the occasion of Indian Newspaper Day, the tiny tots at Shiksha enthusiastically explored newspapers, turning each page with curiosity and excitement



As the children observed pictures, headlines, and news stories, their young minds were nurtured with early awareness of important happenings in the country

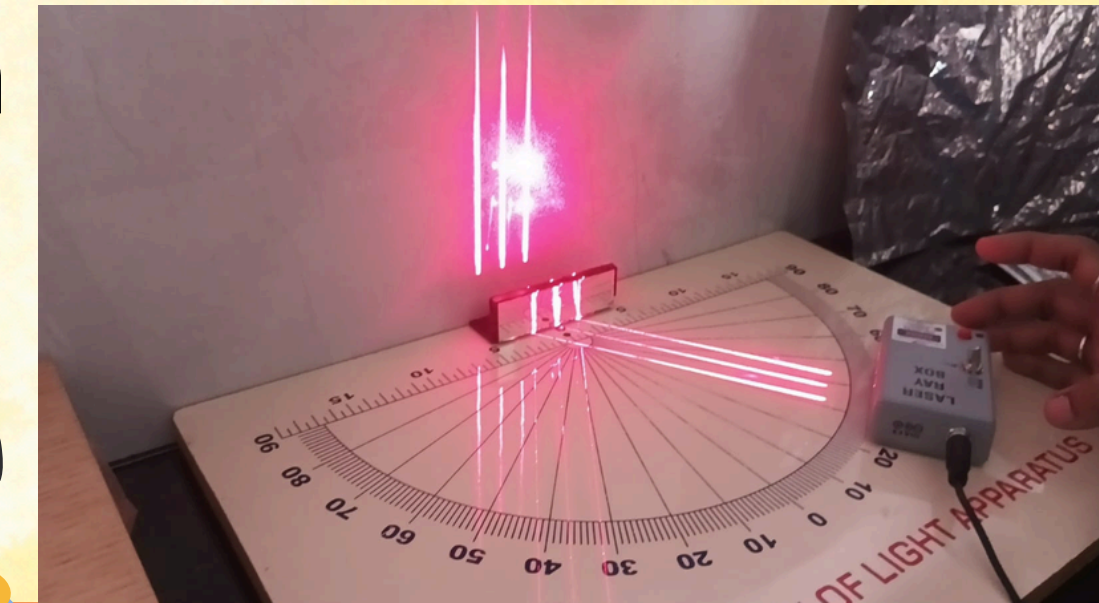
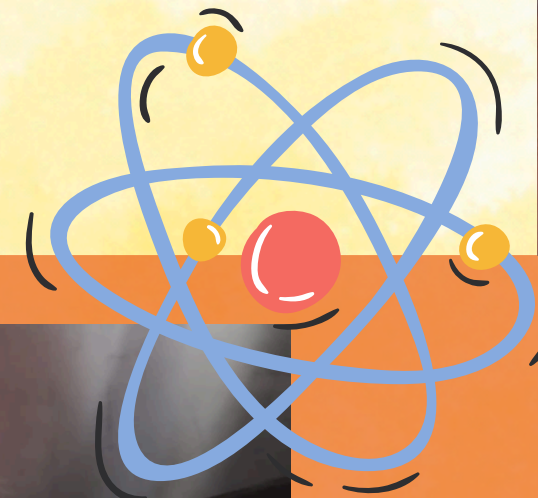


# Exploring the Laws of Reflection Through Experimentation

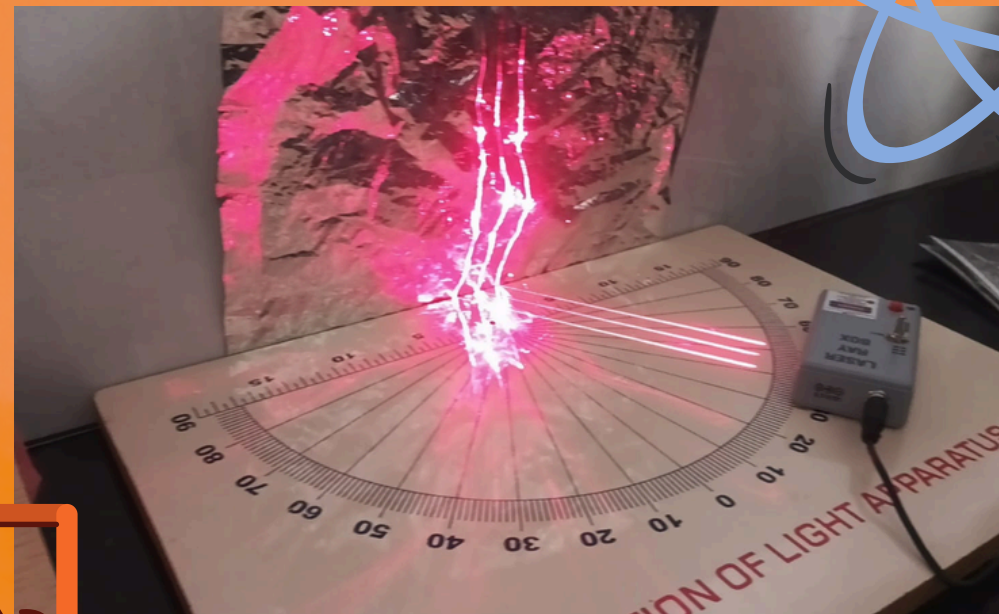


Grade 7 students explored the laws of reflection through practical activities using plane mirrors and ray diagrams.

$$KE = \frac{1}{2}mv^2$$



By observing the path of light rays, students verified that light follows fixed rules and reflects in a predictable manner.



They studied reflection on smooth surfaces and learned that parallel rays form clear images in mirrors, known as regular reflection.

The future of India begins with its young citizens, and our little ones at Shiksha Niketan beautifully expressed their love for the nation through a patriotic performance

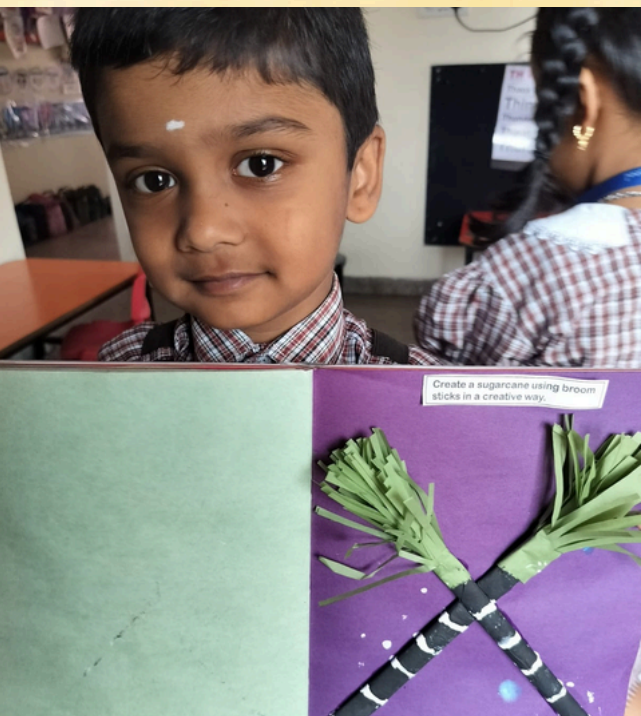
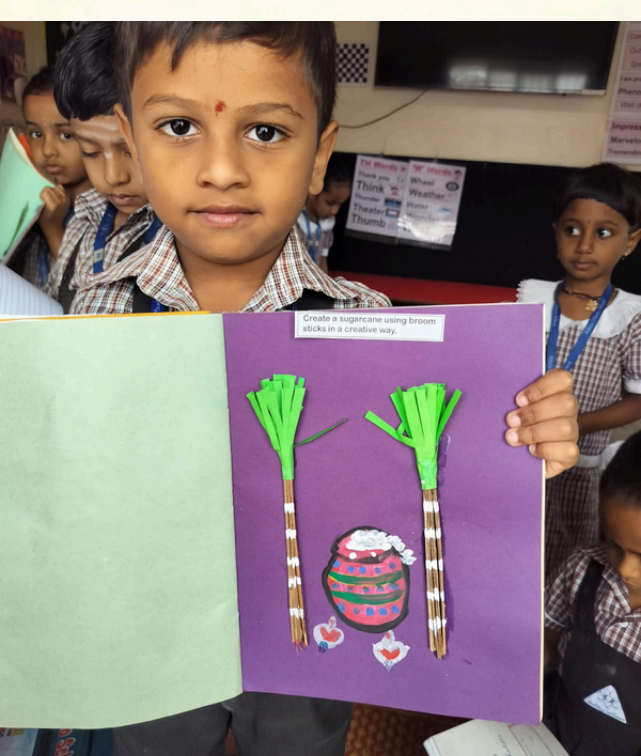


The theme “Unity in Diversity” was creatively enacted by comparing India to a train that runs not on coal or electricity, but on unity
