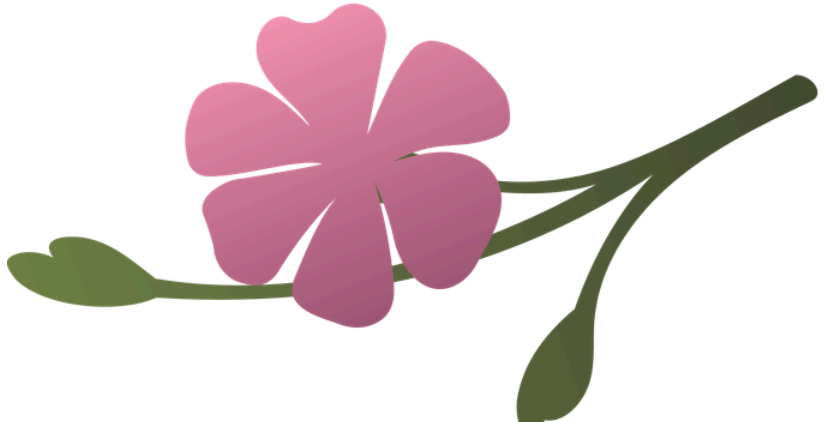

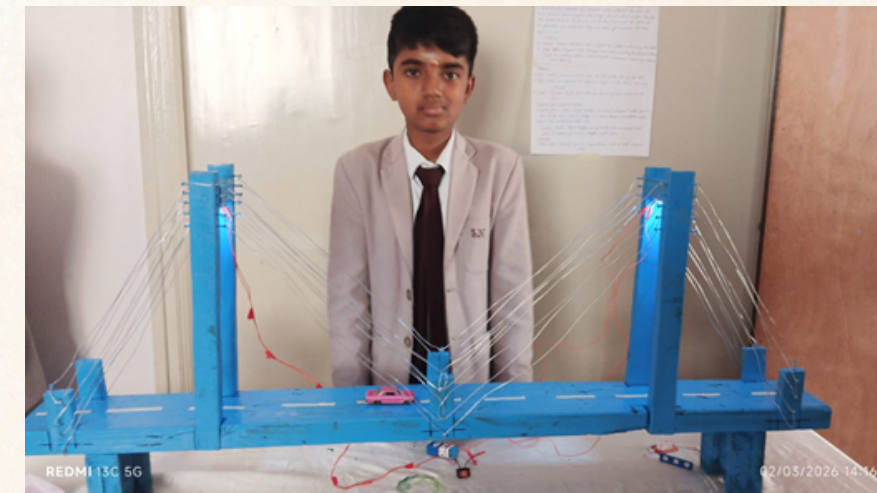
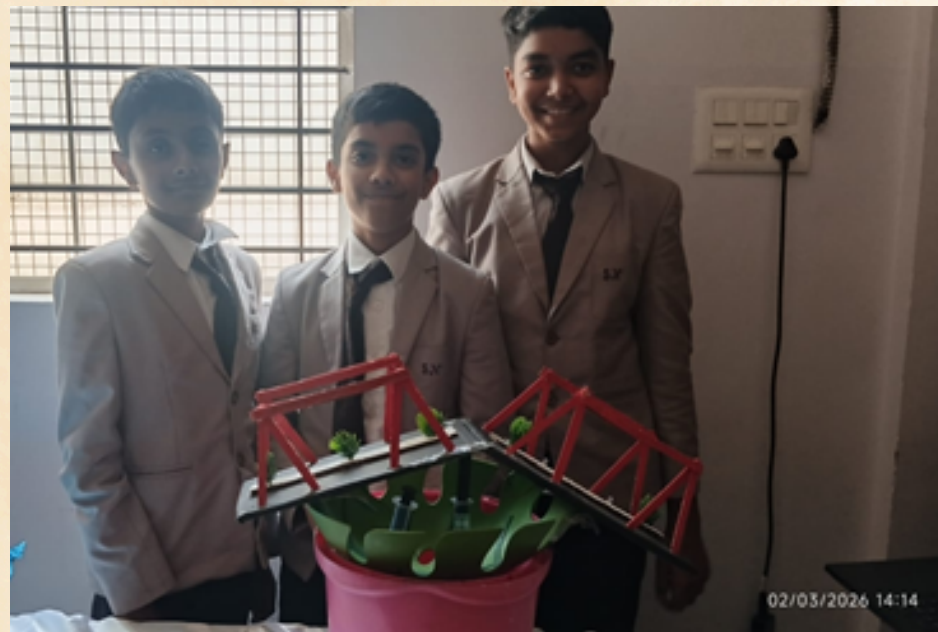


Seaside Fun at Shiksha

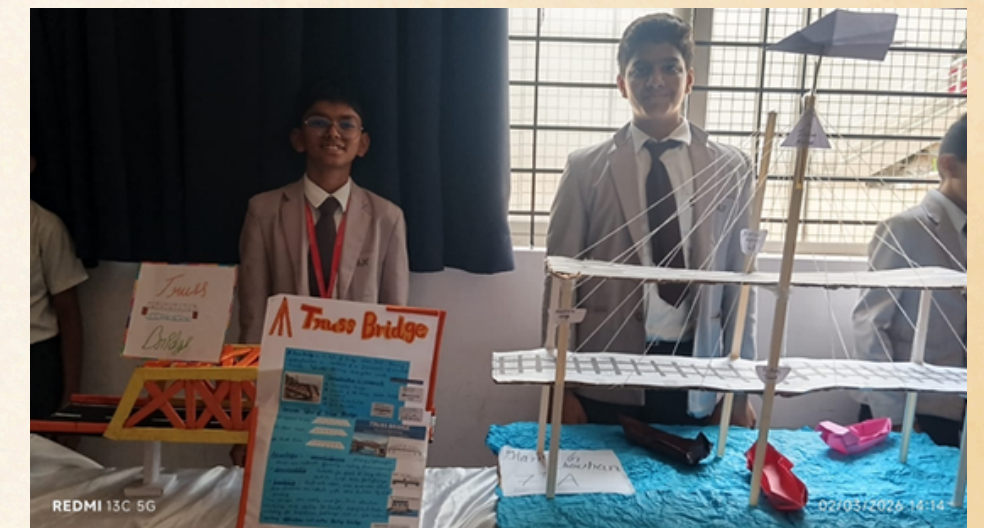

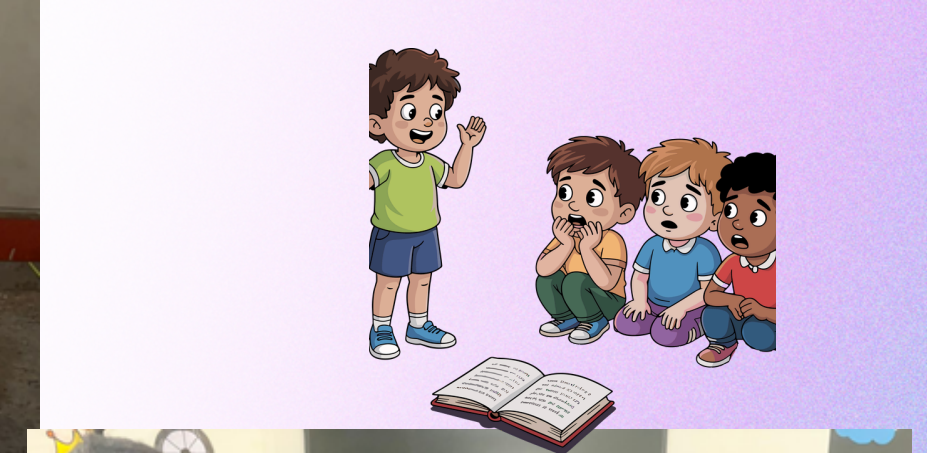
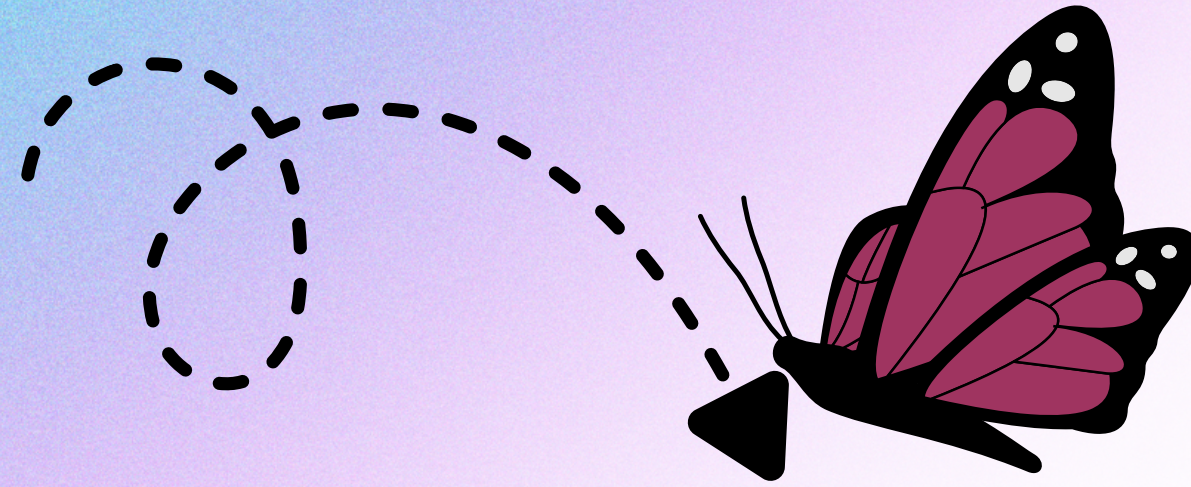
